

# ANIMAL WELFARE WITH JOULES

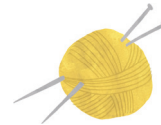
Joules is committed to ensuring that all of its products are produced to safeguard the welfare of animals. All suppliers must conform to the Joules Animal Welfare Policy to demonstrate that the source of the animal product meet the requirements of this policy.

The Joules Animal Welfare Policy ensures animals are raised under recognised higher animal welfare standards, based on the IOE's Animal Health Codes or the Farm Animal Welfare Committee's Five Freedoms.



## LEATHER

All leather must be from sources that meet our policy requirements including higher welfare standards. Joules are proud members of the LWG (Leather Working Group), all of our leather products are sourced from LWG approved tanneries.



## WOOL

All Wool must be sourced with good animal husbandry. Joules prohibits suppliers from using wool that has been obtained through the process of mulesing. Joules are working to source all wool through certified responsible sources.



## EXOTIC SKINS

Suppliers must not use any animal materials which are considered exotic. This includes reptile and ostrich skins.



## ANIMAL TESTING

Joules does not allow animal testing for any of our products. All Joules cosmetics must be Leaping Bunny certified cruelty free.



## HAIR

Suppliers must ensure that all our animal hair and other fibres have been removed using best practice shearing, combing and harvesting techniques.



## FEATHERS & DOWN

Joules only accept down from farms that are certified according to the Responsible Down Standard (RDS) or certified recycled by the Global Recycled Standard (GRS).



## FUR

Joules does not sell products made of real fur. This includes farmed fur such as rabbit, mink, fox, angora and sable.



## ANGORA & OTHER RABBIT HAIR

Angora and other rabbit hair are no longer used in Joules products.
